DIETHYLSTILBESTROL

Diethylstilbestrol is a synthetic non-steroidal estrogen agent. It has been used in estrogen responsive urinary incontinence in dogs.

How do I give this medication?

- Give this medication to your pet as directed by your veterinarian.
 READ THE LABEL CAREFULLY.
- Give this medication one hour before or two hours after meals.
- **DO NOT** give the pet more medicine than directed.
- **DO NOT** give the medicine more often than directed.

How do I store this medicine?

- Keep this medicine out of reach of children.
- Store this medicine in a cool, dry place at room temperature. Store away from heat and direct sunlight.
- Do not store this medicine in the bathroom, near the kitchen sink or in damp places. The medicine may break down if exposed to heat or moisture.

What are the potential side effects?

- Your pet may experience some abnormalities in the blood. Contact your veterinarian if you notice any unusual behavior in your pet.
- Other side effects may occur. If you notice anything unusual, contact your veterinarian.

Are there any possible drug interactions?

- Make sure to tell your veterinarian what other medication you are giving to your pet.
- Periodic blood monitoring is recommended while on this medication.
- The following drugs can potentially interact with diethylstilbestrol: phenobarbital, corticosteroid agents, and oral anticoagulants.
- Contact your veterinarian if your pet experiences any unusual reactions when different medications are given together.
